Rebecca Wolf DiBiase is an expert in school district accountability, human resources, performance management, and charter schools. Wolf DiBiase is a director at The Eli and Edythe Broad Foundation, a national venture philanthropy dedicated to dramatically improving K-12 urban public education through better governance, management, labor relations and competition. She oversees the program investment team and manages the foundation's investments in urban school district strategic redesign, including systems that hold staff performance and resources accountable to district goals and progress and efforts to make human resources operations efficient and effective. She also oversees the foundation's investments to expand charter schools nationwide, most notably in Los Angeles, New York City and New Orleans. Previously, Wolf DiBiase was director of accountability for the Massachusetts' Department of Education's charter school office. She also worked for the Pioneer Institute for Public Policy Research, focusing on K-12 policy reforms and urban entrepreneurship. Earlier in her career, Wolf DiBiase taught middle school in Tegucigalpa, Honduras. Wolf DiBiase currently sits on the boards of three high-performing charter school management organizations: KIPP L.A., Aspire Public Schools, Calif. and the Alliance for College Ready Schools, Calif.
